Families formed by foster care, kinship care, or adoption, especially those raising children with special needs, face unique challenges.

Formed Families Forward helps families find and navigate services here in Northern Virginia, including:

- Early intervention for infants and toddlers
- Instruction and support in schools
- Mental and behavioral health services
- Juvenile justice, courts, and detention
- Health and disability services
- Social services
- Transition through middle and high school to college, job training, and employment

- Free consultations, in-person and by phone
- Assistance with navigating systems, applying for benefits, and advocating for children and youth in your care
- Lending library of books on disability and foster, adoptive and kinship topics
